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LETTER DATED 12 MARCH 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following violations by Iraq of the provisions of the cease-fire between the two States:

1. On 1 November 1991, a group of 21 persons from the Iraqi side engaged in observation of the area at the geographical coordinates of NC 432-659 on the map of Naft Shahr.
2. On 1 November 1991, 10 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving from the geographical coordinates of NC 470-510 on the map of Sumar towards the geographical coordinates of NC 470-500 on the map of Sumar.
3. On 2 November 1991, two Iraqi personnel were observed defusing a mine at the geographical coordinates of NC 534-448 on the map of Sumar.
4. On 3 November 1991, a number of Iraqi soldiers were observed handling ammunition boxes at the geographical coordinates of NC 536-448 on the map of Sumar.
5. On 3 November 1991, nine Iraqi soldiers were observed defusing mines at the geographical coordinates of NC 536-448 on the map of Sumar. As a result of the explosion of a mine an Iraqi soldier was injured and transferred to the rear.
6. On 3 November 1991, three Iraqi officers from the station at the geographical coordinates of NC 531-448 on the map of Sumar engaged in observation of the area.
7. On 3 November 1991, Iraqi forces installed a flag at the geographical coordinates of PB 203-435 to the south of border pillar No. 25/11.

8. On 7 November 1991, from 0940 to 1100 hours, a group of Iraqi personnel, including 20 military police, using seven vehicles, including a command jeep armed with 106 millimetre machine gun, were observed at the geographical coordinates of ND 390-126 on the map of Khosrawi.
9. On 8 November 1991, at 0730 hours, an Iraqi officer along with three soldiers were observed in reconnaissance operation at the geographical coordinates of NC 581-381 on the map of Sumar.
10. On 8 November 1991, at 1700 hours, a station abandoned at the geographical coordinates of NC 716-223 on the map of Halaleh was reoccupied by about 20 Iraqi soldiers.
11. On 8 November 1991, Iraqi forces deployed a heavy machine gun at the geographical coordinates of ND 384-124 on the map of Khosrawi.
12. On 8 November 1991, at 0930 hours, a number of Iraqi soldiers were observed at the geographical coordinates of QA 495-486 on the map of Yabis.
13. On 8 November 1991, at 1030 hours, three Iraqi vehicles carrying a number of Iraqis in non-military clothing made a stop at the geographical coordinates of QA 488-501 on the map of Yabis, across from Iranian border post at Fakke.
14. On 8 November 1991, at 1040 hours, four Iraqi persons with one vehicle using binoculars, at the geographical coordinates of 800-081 on the map of Chay Ghare Tappeh, conducted the identification of Iranian border posts.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
