LETTER DATED 17 MARCH 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to report the following violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

- 1. On 24 November 1991, a group of four Iraqi soldiers were observed at the geographical coordinates of NC 570-380 on the map of Sumar.
- 2. On 24 November 1991, a group of seven Traqi men in Arabic attire were observed defusing mine at the geographical coordinates of PB 087~715 on the map of Mehran.
- 3. On 24 November 1991, at 1000 hours, a group of seven Iraqi men in Arabic attire were observed clearing and defusing mine fields at the geographical coordinates of PB 080-705 on the map of Mehran.
- 4. On 25 November 1991, at 1220 hours, a group of Iraqi soldiers unloaded a number of boxes from two military trucks at the geographical coordinates of QA 49-50 on the map of Yabis.
- 5. On 26 November 1991, 13 Iraqi persons were transported with a white colour vehicle and stationed at the geographical coordinates of NC 580-380 on the map of Sumar.
- 6. On 26 November 1991, 15 Traqi vehicles of heavy and light types were observed moving from the geographical coordinates of EN 98-51 on the map of Marivan towards the geographical coordinates of EN 91-42 on the map of Marivan within the area of separation.
- 7. On 28 November 1991, at 0920 hours, five Iraqi persons were observed searching in several trenches at the geographical coordinates of 521-796 on the map of Sizdeh.
- 8. On 28 November 1991, at 0220 hours, six Iraqi soldiers were observed at the geog: phical coordinates of 590-330 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.

- 9. On 28 November 1991, a group of 13 Traqi soldiers were observed digging a trench at the geographical coordinates of 390-023 on the map of Khosrawi.
- 10. On 2 December 1991, at 1020 hours, Iraqi forces deployed a heavy machine-gun at the geographical coordinates of 432-562 on the map of Naft-Shahr.
- 11. On 2 December 1991, at 1700 hours, a group of eight Iraqi persons engaged in reconnaissance operation at the geographical coordinates of 580-380 on the map of Sumar.
- 12. On 5 December 1991, at 1030 hours, a group of nine Iraqi persons engaged in reconnaissance operation at the geographical coordinates of NC 430-666 on the map of Naft-Shahr.
- 13. On 5 December 1991, at 1020 hours, two bulldozers were observed repairing the road at the geographical coordinates of QA 48-49 on the map of Yabis.
- 14. On 8 December 1991, at 1550 hours, three Iraqi soldiers were observed installing barbed wires at the geographical coordinates of QA 291-821 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
- 15. On 9 December 1991, at 1400 hours, an Iraqi soldier armed with heavy machine-gun was observed behind an observation post at the geographical coordinates of QA 291-821 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
- 16. On 12 December 1991, four Iraqi mechanical shovels were observed at the geographical coordinates of PB 355-420 on the map of Kooh Toonel moving northward. They stopped and engaged in digging the ground.
- 17. On 13 December 1991, two Iraqi mechanical shovels and one loader were observed constructing a trench at the geographical coordinates of PB 353-435 on the map of Kooh Tochel.
- 18. On 16 December 1991, a group of eight Iraqi soldiers were observed constructing a trench at the geographical coordinates of NC 492-842 on the map of Sizdeh.
- 19. On 17 December 1991, five Iraqi soldiers in camouflage uniforms were observed installing an observation post at the geographical coordinates of NC 415-699 on the map of Naft-Shahr.
