BELGIUM

Belgium faithfully applies all the provisions of Security Council resolution 591 (1986).

BULGARTA

The Government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria has repeatedly expressed its serious concern at the threat to international peace and security being posed by South Africa's policy of aggression and apartheid. Today the cessation of any form of co-operation with the racist Pretoria régime and the latter's total isolation constitute the most important and overriding goal with a view to compelling South Africa to comply with the will of the international community.

Guided by this understanding, the Bulgarian Government fully supports and strictly abides by all decisions and resolutions adopted by the Security Council and the General Assembly on the question of South Africa's policy of apartheid. As is well known, the People's Republic of Bulgaria maintains no political, economic, trade, cultural, sport or any other relations with South Africa. At the same time, the People's Republic of Bulgaria categorically condemns the support that certain Western Governments continue to provide to the racist régime and views this support as the principal impediment to the elimination of apartheid and the just settlement of the issues pertaining to South Africa.

The Government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria will continue to support in a practical way the efforts of the United Nations aimed at the total isolation of the criminal Pretoria régime and at the termination of any co-operation with it by Governments, corporations and international organizations until the ultimate restoration of the legitimate rights of the peoples of South Africa and Namibia and the eradication of the system of apartheid have been achieved.

FINLAND

[17 August 1987]

In accordance with the arms embargo by the Security Council in 1977, any provision to the Republic of South Africa of arms and related material of all types, including the sale and transfer of weapons and ammunition, military vehicles

and equipment, paramilitary police equipment and spare parts for the aforementioned, was prohibited by the Presidential Decree of 23 December 1977.

In June 1987, the Finnish Parliament adopted a law which prohibits all imports from South Africa to Finland and all exports from Finland to South Africa.

Finland has no co-operation with South Africa in the military or nuclear fields.
