**NOTE VERBALE DATED 9 APRIL 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF BOLIVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Representative of Bolivia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the note to the Secretary-General dated 2 April 1992 from Mr. Ronald MacLean Abaroa, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Bolivia, conveying Bolivia's acceptance of Security Council resolution 748 (1992), requests that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.

Affairs of Bolivia addressed to the Secretary-General

On behalf of the Bolivian people and Government and reaffirming the principles of Bolivian foreign policy, I wish to inform you of our total acceptance of resolution 748 (1992), adopted by the Security Council at its 3063rd meeting on 31 March 1992, which reaffirms Security Council resolution 731 (1992) of 21 January 1992.

The Constitutional Government of Bolivia is convinced that the elimination of acts of international terrorism is essential for the maintenance of international peace and security. Therefore, while respecting the principles of the Charter of the United Nations, it reiterates once again that, in accordance with the principle laid down in Article 2, paragraph 4, of the Charter, all States have the duty to refrain from organizing or instigating acts of terrorism in other States.

Accordingly, the Government of Bolivia will act in a manner consistent with the resolutions mentioned, particularly as regards Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.
