OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY ON THE AERIAL AND NAVAL
MILITARY ATTACK AGAINST THE SOCIALIST PEOPLE'S LIBYAN ARAB
JAMAHIRIYA BY THE PRESENT UNITED STATES ADMINISTRATION
IN APRIL 1986

Addendum

This report is submitted in connection with paragraph 4 of General Assembly
resolution 41/38 of 20 November 1986, which reads as follows:

"The General Assembly,

"Having heard the statement of the representative of the Socialist
People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya,

"Reaffirming the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United
Nations and the obligation of all States to refrain from the threat or use of
force in their international relations and to settle their disputes by
peaceful means,

"Reaffirming also the inalienable right of all peoples to determine their
own form of government and to choose their political, social and economic
system without any interference, subversion, coercion or constraint of any
kind whatsoever,

"Recalling its resolution 40/157 of 16 December 1985 on the strengthening of security and co-operation in the Mediterranean region,

"Deeply concerned at the threats and aggressive provocations, and the imposition of comprehensive cultural and economic sanctions, including the freezing of assets and properties, carried out against the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya,

"Deeply concerned also at the series of disinformation campaigns carried out against the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya,

"Gravely concerned at the aerial and naval military attack perpetrated against the cities of Tripoli and Benghazi on 15 April 1986, which constitutes a serious threat to peace and security in the Mediterranean region,

"Noting with concern that the Security Council has been prevented from discharging its responsibilities owing to the negative vote of certain permanent members,

"Taking into consideration the Declaration adopted by the Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the Organization of African Unity at its twenty-second ordinary session, held at Addis Ababa from 28 to 30 July 1986,

"Taking note of the Political Declaration adopted by the Eighth Conference of Heads of State or Government of Non-Aligned Countries, held at Harare from 1 to 6 September 1986, and other relevant declarations of the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries in this context,

"Taking note also of the final communiqué adopted at the Co-ordination Meeting of the Ministers for Foreign Affairs of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, held in New York on 2 October 1986,

"1. Condemns the military attack perpetrated against the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya on 15 April 1986, which constitutes a violation of the Charter of the United Nations and of international law;

"2. Calls upon the Government of the United States in this regard to refrain from the threat or use of force in the settlement of disputes and differences with the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and to resort to peaceful means in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations;

"3. Calls upon all States to refrain from extending any assistance or facilities for perpetrating acts of aggression against the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya;

"4. Affirms the right of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya to receive appropriate compensation for the material and human losses inflicted upon it;

"5. Requests the Security Council to remain seized of the matter and requests the Secretary-General to report thereon to the General Assembly at its forty-second session."

Introduction

Following the barbaric aggression launched by the Government of the United States of America against the city centres of Tripoli and Benghazi and some of the outlying areas of these two Libyan cities on 15 April 1987, the Libyan Arab authorities established a Committee to assess the casualties, with a view to the preparation of a report on the damage resulting from the armed aggression perpetrated by the United States Government. The Committee is composed of representatives of the secretariats concerned and experts. The members of the Committee inspected the locations that had been exposed to the aggression in order to find out the damage done to homes, other buildings, property and other installations. The Committee gathered information from officials at the locations subjected to the aggression, the families of victims and others who had been close to the damaged sites and the owners and occupants of destroyed or damaged buildings.

The Committee prepared its report on the basis of the information provided to it on its visits to the places that had been exposed to the aggression and the testimony which it gathered from the parties concerned. At all events, this report and the evaluation of casualties has an indicative value, because an evaluation of the casualties in no way represents the damage done to the people of the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

This is especially true, when the fact is taken into consideration that the primary target of the aggression was the life of Colonel Muammar Qaddafi, the leader of the glorious 1 September revolution. This has been admitted by officials in President Reagan's Administration. Such an attempt on the part of any State is unprecedented in history, inasmuch as dozens of United States warplanes dropped their destructive bombs on the home of the leader of the revolution, which resulted in the death of his adopted daughter, Hana, who was 16 months old.

This barbarous act of aggression against the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya caused the loss of many lives and extensive material damage.

This aggression constitutes a blatant violation of the provisions and norms of international law and also of the principles laid down in the Charter of the United Nations and a blatant exercise in official terrorism carried out by a major Power against a small country.

This aggression is a link in the chain of acts of aggression carried out by the United States Administration against the Libyan Arab people, with the help of a disinformation campaign for which it marshalled its powerful information media. In spite of this, officials in the United States Administration were unable to continue their disinformation campaign, which major officials admitted was spurious, and it was exposed.

The Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya reserves its right to obtain full and comprehensive compensation from the United States of America for all the material and moral losses resulting from the United States policy of aggression which the United States Administration pursues against it.

The Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya considers that the right to compensation is but one of the legal effects arising from the international crime which has been condemned by the international community, represented by the General Assembly of the United Nations, the Security Council having been prevented from shouldering its responsibility with regard to condemnation of this crime owing to abuse of the veto by one of its permanent members. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 41/38, paragraph 4 of which affirms the right of the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya to receive appropriate compensation for the material and human losses inflicted upon it, it has the honour to submit to the Secretary-General of the United Nations this report on the losses and damage resulting from the aggression.

I. Dead

Annex I contains a list of the names of the persons who were martyred as a result of the aggression. It is clear from this list that 41 people died, including one Syrian citizen, the rest being Libyans.

The value of human lives cannot be assessed, and it is extremely difficult, indeed impossible, to evaluate this loss in material terms. However, the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya claims payment of just compensation that takes account of the rights of the victims and their heirs, for these heirs were afflicted with a dual loss. On the one hand, most of them were deprived of the family breadwinner, who provided for their maintenance, while, on the other hand, they were afflicted with a moral loss that cannot be redeemed by any compensation, however great, except in so far as it may alleviate certain of its aspects. Compensation for the victims should be on the basis of the losses of human lives and of material and moral losses.

The Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya reserves its right to submit subsequently all data that may assist in the assessment of compensation to families of victims.

II. Wounded

Annex II contains a list of the names of 226 persons who received hospital treatment for wounds inflicted on them as a result of the aggression.

These wounded have a right to compensation for their material and moral loss. The compensation should cover the costs of their treatment and the care which they require as a result of the total or partial disability which they suffered, whether temporary or permanent. These wounded persons have a right to compensation also for their physical and moral suffering.

It should be pointed out here that it is difficult to determine with absolute certainty the consequences of the injuries and the resultant state of disability or to evaluate the effects.

The competent authorities in the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya reserve their right to transmit all data that may constitute a basis for the compensation of the wounded and their families.

III. Material losses

1. In the city of Tripoli

(a) Damage to residential buildings

The competent committee made an inventory of the damage resulting from the United States aggression by visiting the sites of the buildings in both Tripoli and Benghazi that had been damaged as a result of the senseless raids carried out by United States war planes. The total number of private residential buildings damaged in the two cities was 607, including 20 buildings totally destroyed as a result of direct hits and 587 buildings damaged in varying degrees. In some cases, the cracks were so extensive that these buildings were ready to collapse at the time when they were being repaired. Other buildings that had been hit appeared to be intact, but faults appear in the course of repairs and upon removal of existing coats of paint.

A number of buildings belonging to foreign embassies in Tripoli suffered varying degrees of damage, extensive in some cases. The buildings of the following States were affected: Syria, Lebanon, Ethiopia, German Democratic Republic, Iran, Czechoslovakia and France. The Romanian Trade Office was also damaged (annex XVII).
