Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with rule 135 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly and rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General has the honour to circulate herewith the application of the Republic of Slovenia for admission to membership in the United Nations, contained in a letter dated 5 May 1992 from the President of the Republic of Slovenia to the Secretary-General.

of Slovenia to the Secretary-General

On behalf of the Republic of Slovenia and in my capacity as President of the Presidency, I have the honour to inform you that the Republic of Slovenia herewith applies for membership in the United Nations.

The democratically elected Government of the Republic of Slovenia is fully executing its control over all its territory and is pursuing peaceful policies in accordance with the principles and purposes of the United Nations.

Even as a constituent part of Yugoslavia, Slovenia made an important contribution in the frame of the participation of former Yugoslavia in the Organization of the United Nations. In full knowledge, therefore, of the rights and obligations which derive from the United Nations Charter, the Republic of Slovenia is prepared honourably to carry out its obligations and actively to participate in the accomplishment of the aims of the World Organization.

Bearing in mind the importance and the universal character of the Organization of the United Nations and in order to contribute to its efforts towards a peaceful solution to the Yugoslav crisis, the Republic of Slovenia has kept the United Nations informed about its views on the causes of this crisis and offered proposals for its peaceful and just settlement.

I would be grateful if you would arrange for the present application to be placed before the Security Council and the General Assembly at the earliest opportunity.

A declaration made in pursuance of rule 134 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly and rule 58 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council is set out hereunder.

Declaration

In connection with the application of the Republic of Slovenia for membership in the United Nations, I have the honour, on behalf of the Republic of Slovenia and in my capacity as President of the Presidency, to solemnly declare that the Republic of Slovenia accepts the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations and undertakes to fulfil them.
