LETTER DATED 21 SEPTEMBER 1987 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform you that on 19 September 1987 the Iranian armed forces committed the following acts of armed aggression against Iraq, bombing residential centres used for purely civilian purposes:

From 2240 until 2400	Chwartah district

Further to our letter dated 19 September 1987, and with reference to the list of casualties and damage caused by the enemy bombing of the town of Sulaymaniyah, the following should be added:

Six killed, including two children and one woman, and 12 dwellings, two civilian vehicles and four commercial premises damaged.
