> NOTE VERERLE DATED 27 APRIL 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OR SPAIN TO THE UNITED HATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Pamanent Mission of Spain to the United Fations presents its compliments to the Secretary-Goneral of the United Nations and, with reference to his note verbale SCPC/1/92 (2) of 3 April 1992, bas the honour to report herein on the measures adopted to date by Spain, at the national level, in implementation of Security Council resolution 748 (1992) of 31 Mareh 1992:
(1) Measures xelated to aerial mayigation. In its note verbale of 15 April. Spain informed Libya that, with effect from the date of the note werbale, all flights, overfilghts and landings in Spain of airtraft taking off from or destined to land in Libya were to cease and that all activities and operations of the offices of the company Libyan Arab Airlines in Spain were to be suspended.

In addition, administrative measures have been taken to implement the set of provisions contained in Security Council resolution 748 (1992) relating to the supply of aircraft or aircraft components, the provision of engineering and maintenance servicing, the certification of airworthiness and insurance for Libyan aircraft.
(2) Militacy embargo. In accordance with the Spanish law currently in force, all exports of weapons and related material require the express authorization of the Inter-Ministerial Board for defence-related and dual-purpose equipmeat. The Board has decided to bring its criteria strictly into line with the provisions of garagraph 5 of resolution 748 (1992).
(3) Measures adopted with respect to the diplomaticmission of Libya in Madrid. In its note verbale of 15 April. Spain informed Libya that the Financial Attaché of the Libyan mission must leave the territory of Spain within 15 days. The abovementioned note verbale also stated that the staff of the Libyan Embessy were not to move outsiae the boundaries of the Autonomous Communicy of Madrid.
