NOTE VERBALE DATED 20 APRIL 1992 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Israel to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the latter's note SCPC/192(2) of 3 April 1992 concerning resolution 748 (1992), which was adopted by the Security Council on 31 March 1992.

The Chargé d'affaires a.i. wishes to inform the Secretary-General that due to the longstanding belligerency of the Libyan regime towards Israel, there exist no relations whatsoever between the two countries and, consequently, there are no ties that would fall under the provisions contained in paragraphs 3 through 7 of resolution 748 (1992).
