ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

Subject: PARTICIPATION OF MISSION STAFF IN THE UNITED
NATIONS JOINT STAFF PENSION FUND

1. Staff rule 106.1 provides that staff members who have been recruited specifically for service with a mission shall not be eligible for participation in the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund unless eligibility for such participation is granted in the letter of appointment.
2. Following provision in the 1971 budget estimates for participation of mission staff in the Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General has decided with effect from 1 January 1971, all local staff serving with missions will become participants in the Fund in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of the Fund.
3. It has been decided that rule 106.1 will be amended, with effect from 1 January 1971, so that exclusion from participation in the Fund can be effected only by a specific condition in the letter of appointment.
4. An appropriate amendment to the Staff Rules will be issued in due course.
