ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

To: Members of the Staff of the United Nations

Subject: PROVISIONAL RULES GOVERNING COMPENSATION TO MEMPERS OF COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES OR SIMILAR BODIES IN CASE OF INJURY OR DEATH ATTRIBUTABLE TO SERVICE WITH THE UNITED NATIONS

- 1. By resolution 458 (V) of 16 November 1950, the General Assembly provided for payment of compensation to members of commissions, committees or similar bodies in case of injury or death attributable to service with the United Nations.
- 2. Under the resolution eligibility for compensation is restricted "solely to those members of commissions, committees or similar bodies whose service to the Organization is recognized to the extent that they receive subsistence allowance from the Organization".
- 3. The provisions of the plan are set out in document ST/SGB/103.
- 4. It will be the responsibility of the Principal Secretary, Secretary, or other senior administrative officer of each commission, committee or similar body concerned, to arrange through the auspices of the Field Operations Service, the Conference Control Section, the Economic and Social Council Secretariat, or the Geneva Office, as appropriate, for a supply of document ST/SGB/103 and of the related form F.142 "Declaration of Dependents" and to make these documents available to each member of such commission, committee or similar body.
- 5. Completed forms F.142 will be maintained on file by the Principal Secretary, Secretary, or other senior administrative officer concerned.
