SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/18570 of 8 January 1987.

During the week ending 19 September 1987, at its 2752nd meeting, held on 14 September 1987, pursuant to resolution 595 (1987) of 27 March 1987, the Security Council proceeded to the election of a member of the International Court of Justice to fill the seat which had become vacant as a result of the death, on 10 March 1987, of Judge Guy Ladréit de Lacharrière.

In the course of the voting, Mr. Gilbert Guillaume (France) received the required majority of votes in the Security Council.

As Mr. Gilbert Guillaume also received the required majority of votes in the General Assembly, he was declared elected a member of the International Court of Justice for a term of office expiring on 5 February 1991.

During that week ending 19 September 1987, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed therein.
