# Paragraph 50 (Participation of non-governmental organizations in the work of the Main Committees)

- 1. The CHAIRMAN said that the consultations on paragraph 50 had not yet been completed. If he heard no objection, he would take it that the Committee agreed to defer its consideration of that paragraph so that the consultations could continue.

# Items proposed for consideration in plenary meeting

3. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration in plenary meeting in the Secretary-General's memorandum, with the addition of items 128 (b), 142, 143, 145 and 146 which the General Committee had decided to recommend for consideration directly in plenary meetings, and excluding item 47, which it had decided to recommend deferring to the forty-third session, as well as items 41 and 43, which it had decided to recommend for consideration in the Fifth Committee, should be allocated to the plenary Assembly.

# Items proposed for consideration by the First Committee

4. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the First Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum, with the exclusion of sub-item 73 (c), which it had decided to recommend deferring to the forty-third session, should be allocated to that Committee.

#### Items proposed for consideration by the Special Political Committee

5. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Special Political Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum should be allocated to that Committee.

### Items proposed for consideration by the Second Committee

6. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Second Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum should be allocated to that Committee.

#### Items proposed for consideration by the Third Committee

7. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Third Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum, including the additional item 144, which the Committee had decided to recommend for consideration in the Third Committee, should be allocated to that Committee.

## Items proposed for consideration by the Fourth Committee

8. Taking into account its decision regarding item 114, the Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Fourth Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum should be allocated to that Committee.

#### Items proposed for consideration by the Fifth Committee

9. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Fifth Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum, including items 41 and 43, should be allocated to that Committee.

#### Items proposed for consideration by the Sixth Committee

10. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the items proposed for consideration by the Sixth Committee in the Secretary-General's memorandum, including the additional sub-item 128 (b), should be allocated to that Committee.
