Subject: PROCEDURE FOR SALE OF COPIES OF UNITED NATIONS SOUND RECORDINGS

1. This instruction supersedes ST/AI/67/Rev.5 of 9 December 1974 on the above subject.

2. Copies of unrestricted United Nations sound recordings are available at cost to delegations, <u>Secretariat staff</u> and the general public. Requests for copies or for information should be addressed to the Sound Recording Unit, Records Management Service, Office of General Services, or in person to room GA-19 (ext. 7660).

3. Charges will be in accordance with the table below with effect from 1 September 1979. Mailing and delivery charges will be added when required. Charges listed are for continuous speeches. If desired, several items may be combined on a reel or cassette, subject to a charge of \$1.50 for each additional item added.
