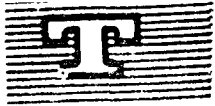

S. RESOLUTION No.2-101

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A SENATE RESOLUTION

Relative to approving the Compact of Free Association and authorizing the implementation thereof by the President of the Republic of Palau.

WHEREAS, it is the urgent desire of the people and the Government of the Republic of Palau to terminate its status as a Trust Territory governed by the United States under a Trusteeship Agreement with the United Nations; and

WHEREAS, it is the urgent desire of the people and the Government of the Republic of Palau to become a sovereign state in the international community; and

WHEREAS, the termination of the Trusteeship and Palauan sovereignty may be achieved upon the adoption of the Compact of Free Association between the Republic of Palau and the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has already approved and adopted the Compact of Free Association; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the Republic of Palau has found the Compact of Free Association to be inconsistent with Article II, Section 3 and Article XIII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Republic of Palau expressly anticipates the need to amend the Constitution for the purpose of avoiding inconsistency with the Compact of Free Association; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the amendatory provisions of Article XV, Section 11 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau, an amendment to resolve these inconsistencies was proposed to the people of Palau; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RPPL No. 2-30 a nationwide referendum was held on August 4, 1987 during which the people of Palau expressly voted affirmatively to amend their Constitution to resolve these inconsistencies; and

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WHEREAS, an overwhelming majority of the people and fourteen of the sixteen states of the Republic of Palau approved the amendment pursuant to Article XV, Section 11 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 1987 the President of the Republic of Palau has certified the results of the constitutional amendment referendum to be authentic, with 73.33% votes for and 26.67% votes against the amendment; and

WHEREAS, once the constitutional amendment is carried and approved according to Article XV, Section 11 of the Constitution and approved by majority vote in at least three-fourths of the States of the Republic of Palau, the compact referendum is in order; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 1987 once again the people of Palau in a nationwide referendum went to the polls and expressed their will and wishes by affirmatively voting to approve the Compact of Free Association, with 73.04% votes for and 26.96% votes against as certified by the President of the Republic of Palau; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Second Olbiil Era Kelulau, Fourteenth Special Session, August 1987, hereby approves the Compact of Free Association pursuant to Article II, Section 3 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau, as the same Compact was approved in a nationwide referendum held on August 21, 1987 pursuant to RPPL No. 2-30; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Republic of Palau is hereby authorized to implement the Compact of Free Association between the Government of the Republic of Palau and the Government of the United States of America, as signed by the President of the Republic of Palau and a representative of the Government of the United States on January 10, 1986, and subsequently approved by the United States Congress; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States of America, to the President of the Republic of Palau, to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the U.S. Congress, to the Director of the Office of the Freely Associated States Affairs in the State Department, to the President of the United Nations Trusteeship Council, and to the Senate President and House Speaker of the Second Olbiil Era Kelulau.
