#### ELECTION OF THE VICE-CHAIRMEN

1. <u>Mr. KAKOLECKI</u> (Poland), speaking on behalf of the Group of Eastern European States, nominated Mr. Mikulka (Czechoslovakia) for one of the posts of Vice-Chairman.

#### 2. Mr. Mikulka (Czechoslovakia) was elected Vice-Chairman by acclamation.

3. <u>Mr. GISLASON</u> (Iceland), speaking on behalf of the Group of Western European and other States nominated Mr. Scharioth (Federal Republic of Germany) for the remaining post of Vice-Chairman.

# 4. <u>Mr. Scharioth (Federal Republic of Germany) was elected Vice-Chairman by</u> acclamation.

ORGANIZATION OF WORK

5. The CHAIRMAN drew the Committee's attention to the letter from the President of the General Assembly (A/AC.6/42/1) indicating the 14 topics allocated to the Sixth Committee, and the note by the Secretariat (A/C.6/42/L.1) on the organization of the Committee's work. As both documents had been distributed only just before the meeting, he took it that representatives would prefer to hold consultations on the organization of work before taking any decisions.

6. After a procedural debate in which <u>Mr. Schricke</u> (France), <u>Mr. Francis</u> (Jamaica) and <u>Mr. Gaudreau</u> (Canada) took part, the Chairman suggested that the consultations on the organization of work should be held before the next meeting.

7. It was so decided.
