NOTE VERBALE DATED 22 MAY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TURKEY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Turkey to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note dated 3 April 1992, has the honour to inform him of the measures taken by Turkey in implementation of Security Council resolution 748 (1992).

All scheduled and non-scheduled flights of Turkish Airlines and other Turkish airline companies to and from the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya have been suspended as of 15 April 1992. Likewise, all flights of Libyan Arab Airlines to and from Turkey have been suspended as of the same date.

The Libyan Arab Airlines offices in Turkey have been closed.

The Government of Turkey has also decided not to grant overflight permission to any military or civilian aircraft flights and or from the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

The supply to the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya by Turkish companies of aircraft and aircraft components, the provision of engineering and maintenance services to Libyan aircraft and the insurance of Libyan aircraft have been prohibited.

Since 1986 Turkey has had no transactions coming within paragraphs 5 (a) and 5 (b) of Security Council resolution 748 (1992).

All measures have been taken to ensure that access to Turkey is denied to Libyan nationals who have been denied entry to or expelled from other States as a result of their terrorist activities.
