Letter dated 5 October 1987 from the Permanent Representative of Costa Rica to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

On behalf of the group of Central American countries which signed the Guatemala Agreement on 7 August 1987 and of the countries members of the Contadora Group and the Support Group, I have the honour to request that item 34 of the agenda of the current session of the General Assembly, entitled "The situation in Central America: threats to international peace and security and peace initiatives", should be considered as a matter of urgency and, if possible, no later than Wednesday, 7 October 1987.

In connection with this matter, the aforementioned countries have formally submitted a draft resolution 1/ for adoption when this item is considered.
