Draft resolution A/CN.11/L.116

138. At the 90th meeting, the representative of Poland introduced a draft resolution entitled "International co-operation on environmental technology" (A/CN.11/L.116), which read as follows:

"The Intergovernmental Committee on Science and Technology for development,

"Recognizing the importance of international efforts, both bilateral and multilateral, to cope successfully with pressing environmental problems, including drought, desertification and other natural disasters,

"Taking note of General Assembly and other United Nations resolutions and decisions on international co-operation in the field of environmental protection,

"Deeply concerned about the further deterioration of the state of environment, referred to at the Congress for a Peaceful Future of the World, held at Warsaw,

"Stressing the necessity of intensified application of science and technology to the study, prevention, monitoring and combating of environmental damage, and to counteract environmental degradation,

"Realizing that effective measures have to be worked out and implemented to protect the environment from negative and harmful aspects of human activities,

"Conscious of the importance of the unhindered exchange of experience, information, technology and know-how to achieve satisfactory results,
