ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 20 May 1992 from the President of the Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the resumed forty-sixth session of the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 755 (1992)) on the admission of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3079th meeting on 20 May 1992:

"The Security Council,

"<u>Having examined</u> the application of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"<u>Recommends</u> to the General Assembly that the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

"<u>1</u>/ A/46/921-S/23971.

I would point out that, when adopting the aforementioned resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in order to submit its recommendation to the resumed forty-sixth session of the General Assembly.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the forty-sixth session of the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 3078th and 3079th meetings of the Council, at which the application of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina was considered.
