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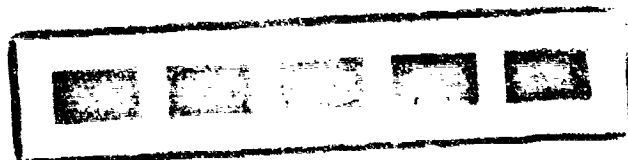
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LETTER DATED 26 MAY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF CANADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In the light of the continuing dangerous situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina and other ex-republics of the former Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, I have been instructed by my Government to request an urgent formal meeting of the Security Council with a view to imposing economic, trade and oil sanctions against the authorities in Belgrade and to consider steps that would allow United Nations-escorted relief convoys to reach civilians in Bosnia and Herzegovina and to open Sarajevo airport for humanitarian reasons.

I would be grateful if you would arrange for this letter to be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
