NOTE VERBALE DATED 15 MAY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF BANGLADESH TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Bangladesh to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him that the following steps have been taken by the Government of Bangladesh to implement Security Council resolution 748 (1992):

1. The weekly Biman Bangladesh Airlines flight to Tripoli has been suspended. Similarly, no Libyan flights are allowed to overfly or land in any Bangladesh airports.
2. The size of the Libyan Embassy at Dhaka is already small and functioning with only two diplomats and accounts attaché. The Bangladesh Embassy at Tripoli is also operating with officers and staff numbering fewer than five.
3. With regard to the arms embargo, Bangladesh has no arms transactions whatsoever with the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.
4. Other provisions of the resolution are also being adhered to.
