NOTE VERBALE DATED 8 JUNE 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF QATAR TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the State of Qatar to the United Nations presents its compliments to His Excellency the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note verbale of 3 June 1992, has the honour to advise that the State of Qatar does not have with Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegra) trade relations of any importance or frequency. In particular, the State of Qatar does not export oil or natural gas to Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegra). Nevertheless, the competent authorities of the State have taken the necessary measures to ban all imports of goods and services from Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegra) and, in general, to fully implement all the provisions of Security Council resolution 757 (1992) in conformity with the State of Qatar's established policy with regard to Security Council resolutions.
