Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a communication dated 8 January 1987, addressed on behalf of the Secretary-General to States parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, attention was drawn to the fact that the terms of office of the following five members of the International Court of Justice will expire on 5 February 1988:

Mr. Roberto Ago (I aly)

Mr. José Sette-Câmara (Brazil)

Mr. Stephen M. Schwebel (United States of America)

Mr. Mohammed Bedjaoui (Algeria)

Mr. Nikolai K. Tarassov (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics)

In conformity with Articles 4 and 13 of the Statute of the Court, the General Assembly and the Security Council, during the forty-second regular session of the General Assembly, will elect five judges for a period of nine years, beginning on 6 February 1988. In accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 5 of the Statute of the Court, national groups were thus invited to undertake the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court, and to submit such nomination to the Secretary-General no later than 15 August 1987.

- 2. In accordance with Article 7 of the Statute of the Court, the Secretary-General has the honour to submit to the General Assembly and to the Security Council a list in alphabetical order of the candidates thus nominated (see annex).
- 3. The composition of the Court and the voting procedure to be followed in the General Assembly and in the Security Council are set out in a memorandum by the Secretary-General, issued as document A/42/588-S/19155. The curricula vitae of the candidates will appear in document A/42/591-S/19158.
