**NOTE VERBALE DATED 22 JUNE 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF SRI LANKA TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Representative of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to the Secretary-General's Note of 3 June 1992, has the honour to state that the Government of Sri Lanka has taken administrative action to implement fully the measures contained in Security Council resolution 757 (1992).

These measures include:

- The freezing with immediate effect of all relevant bank accounts, including foreign currency banking unit accounts of Yugoslavia and its agencies, privately owned enterprises and accounts of individuals;
- The Central Bank of Sri Lanka has advised all banks and authorized dealers in Sri Lanka accordingly, with a view to freezing economic activity between the two countries;
- The Director of Commerce has advised the business community through the Chamber of Commerce and Industry to take measures in compliance with Security Council resolution 757 (1992);
- The Director of Civil Aviation has issued instructions to enforce the stoppage of aviation activity.

In addition, action is being taken to reduce the level of staff at the Sri Lanka Embassy at Belgrade.
