NOTE VERBALE DATED 18 JUNE 1992 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF UNUGUAY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations presents her compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to respond to the latter's nate SCPC/1/92(2) of 15 June 1992 and, with regard to paragraphs 3 to 7 of Security Council resolution 748 (1992), of 31 March 1992, to inform him as follows:

Uruguay has adopted the necessary measures to ensure strict compliance with Security Council resolution 748 (1992).

In that respect it should be noted that Uruguay has no diplomatic staff in Libya and that there is no diplomatic mission of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya in Uruguay. Moreover, Uruguay does not receive flights originating in Libya, there being no cooperation of any kind between the two countries in the aeronautical sphere.

Uruquay is neither a producer nor an exporter of arms.

It would be greatly appreciated if this note could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
