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LETTER DATED 24 JUNE 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 12 June 1991, at 1950 hours, Iraqi forces disembarked ammunition boxes from an IFA vehicle at the geographical coordinates of 418-081 on the map of Khosravi.
2. On 12 June 1991, from 0800 hours to 1200 hours, a number of Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 104-731 on the map of Mehran, planted mines along the road for 150 metres.
3. On 14 June 1991, at 2000 hours, three Iraqi forces were approaching an Iranian observation post at the geographical coordinates of 718-221 on the map of Halaleh; they ran back when an illuminating mine was activated.
4. On 15 June 1991, a patrol unit penetrated Darkhourd bridge at the geographical coordinates of 425-335 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin and a number of Iraqi forces began advancing from Ahangaran pass at the geographical coordinates of 672-244 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
5. On 14 June 1991, a bunker was constructed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 32-70 on the map of Kuh-Gach.
6. On 15 June 1991, 30 Iraqi forces cleared up an area at the geographical coordinates of 496-497 and 489-509 on the map of Sumar.
7. On 14-16 June 1991, Iraqi forces began planting mines around 300 to 500 metres long at the geographical coordinates of 42-63 on the map of Naft-Shahr.
8. On 17 June 1991, at 0800 hours, a number of Iraqi forces were observed digging a canal at the geographical coordinates of 590-330 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.

9. On 18 June 1991, two bunkers were constructed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 107-723 and 107-721 on the map of Mehran.
10. On 24 June 1991, Iraqi forces planted mines 60 metres in depth and 100 metres in width at the geographical coordinates of 706-212 on the map of Chazabeh.
11. On 30 June 1991, at 1600 hours, Iraqi forces stationed at Agh-Dagh fired several Dush-K shells which fell at the geographical coordinates of 490-256 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
12. On 6 July 1991, a group bunker was restored by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 591-361 on the map of Sumar.
13. On 9 July 1991, four Iraqi forces were observed penetrating at the geographical coordinates of 289-823 on the map of Nahr Anbar.
14. On 11 July 1991, 10 Iraqi forces began surveying at the geographical coordinates of 031-672 and 301-673 on the map of Mehran.
15. On 12 July 1991, five Iraqi forces surveyed the area at the geographical coordinates of 29-82 on the map of Nahr Anbar.
16. On 14 July 1991, at 1630 hours, an Iraqi loader was observed constructing an embankment at the geographical coordinates of 55-41 on the map of Sumar.
17. On 16 July 1991, four Iraqi forces began surveying at the geographical coordinates of 873-125 on the map of Halaleh.
18. On 18 July 1991, 12 Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the geographical coordinates of 538-247 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
19. On 20 July 1991, a bunker was constructed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 404-111 on the map of Khosravi.
20. On 20 July 1991, a tank was deployed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 593-325 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.
21. On 21 July 1991, at 0300 hours, an illuminating bullet was fired by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 538-247 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
22. On 21 July 1991, Iraqi forces were observed digging a canal at the geographical coordinates of 293-821 on the map of Nahr Anbar.
23. On 21 July 1991, Iraqi forces were reinforced with an infantry battalion from the geographical coordinates of 620-250 to the geographical coordinates of 490-290 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
24. On 22 July 1991, at 0345 hours, an illuminating bullet was fired by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 879-062 on the map of Anjireh.

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25. On 22 July 1991, Iraqi forces installed a row of barbed wire at the geographical coordinates of 080-690 on the map of Mehran.
26. On 25 July 1991, construction materials for bunkers were disembarked by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 919-003 on the map of Gotbeh mountain.
27. On 27 July 1991, a bunker was constructed by eight Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 415-103 on the map of Khosravi.
28. On 27 July 1991, four Iraqi forces, clothed in Kakhi and green outfits, were seen at the geographical coordinates of 29-82 on the map of Nahr Anbar.
29. On 28 July 1991, a bunker was constructed by seven Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 107-723 on the map of Mehran.
30. On 28 July 1991, 10 Iraqi forces got out of a vehicle at the geographical coordinates of 994-956 on the map of Meimeh.
31. On 12 August 1991, at 0930 hours, 15 Iraqi forces were observed constructing two sun-shelters at the geographical coordinates of 536-442 on the map of Sumar.
32. On 3 August 1991, an individual bunker was constructed by Iraqi forces at at the geographical coordinates of 465-157 on the map of Kharatha.
33. On 4 August 1991, Iraqi forces fired with small-caliber gun from Shino area across from L 16 area at Iranian forces.
34. On 7 August 1991, 15 Iraqi forces were observed digging a canal and individual bunkers at the geographical coordinates of 594-335 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.
35. On 10 August 1991, two illuminating bullets were fired by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 107-723 on the map of Mehran.
36. On 12 August 1991, four Iraqi forces dug a canal at the geographical coordinates of 594-335 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.
37. On 12 August 1991, Iraqi forces began restoring and constructing observation posts at the geographical coordinates of 705-211 on the map of Chazabeh.
38. On 13 August 1991, a bunker was constructed by six Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 887-035 on the map of Gotbeh mountain.
39. On 14 August 1991, Iraqi forces were reinforced with 20 soldiers aboard an IFA vehicle at the geographical coordinates of 682-241 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.

40. On 15 August 1991, two sand-bag bunkers were constructed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 107-723 on the map of Mehran.
41. On 16 August 1991, Iraqi forces launched seven illuminating mortar shells and fired with light-weight weapons at the geographical coordinates of 453-157 on the map of Khosravi.
42. On 18 August 1991, a bunker was constructed by seven Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 402-114 on the map of Halaleh.
43. On 18 August 1991, a bunker was constructed by eight Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 714-220 on the map of Halaleh.
44. On 21 August 1991, a bunker was constructed by nine Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 402-114 on the map of Khosravi.
45. On 21 August 1991, seven Iraqi forces were seen planting mines at the geographical coordinates of 097-716 and 096-718 on the map of Mehran.
46. On 22 August 1991, at 1700 hours, an automatic machine-gun was deployed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 432-667 on the map of Naft-Shahr.
47. On 23 August 1991, three observation posts were constructed by Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 475-207 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
48. On 23 August 1991, an observation post was constructed by five Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 627-249 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
49. On 23 August 1991, a bunker was constructed by five Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 714-220 on the map of Halaleh.
50. On 23 August 1991, a row of barbed wire was installed by four Iraqi forces at the geographical coordinates of 293-821 on the map of Nahr Anbar.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
