NOTE VARBALE DATED 22 JUNE 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Korea to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform the latter that the Government of the Republic of Korea has taken the following measures to implement Security Council resolution 757 (1:12).

- 1. Measures related to trade. The Ministry of Trade and Industry has issued an administrative order which prohibits trade or any activities to promote the trade and dealing in commodities and products, with the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), in compliance with paragraph 4 of resolution 757 (1992).
- 2. Measures related to funds. Pursuant to paragraph 5 of resolution 757 (1992), the Ministry of Finance has issued an administrative order which prohibits all financial agencies, including banks, from removing or remitting any funds or any financial or economic resources to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.
- 3. Measures related to aircraft. The Ministry of Transportation has ordered airport authorities and airline companies to comply with paragraph 7 of resolution 757 (1992), although no airlink exists between the two countries.
- 4. Other measures. The Ministry of Sports and Youth has prohibited the participation by any teams representing the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in the international sporting events that will take place in the Republic of Korea in 1992.

The ministries concerned have held in abeyance the scientific and technical cooperation and cultural exchanges with the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia until further notice.
