Statement on the bombardment of Gorazde

(European Political Cooperation press release of 14 July 1992)

The European Community and its member States make clear their condemnation of the bombardment by Serb forces of the city of Gorazda and other cities in Bosnia. These brutal and indiscriminate attacks upon defenceless civilians are whole contrary to the basic humanitarian precepts of international law.

They call for an immediate end to these attacks, urgent measures to relieve the suffering and deprivation of the population, and for a resumption, without preconditions and in good faith by all parties concerned, of serious negotiations in Lord Carrington's conference.
