**NOTE VERBALE DATED 14 JULY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT  
MISSION OF TUNISIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Mission of Tunisia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to his note of 3 June 1992 in which he requests information on the measures taken by the Tunisian Government in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 4 to 9 of Security Council resolution 757 (1992), has the honour to inform him that Tunisia has taken all the necessary steps to implement that resolution.

Although it is linked to the former Federal Republic of Yugoslavia by numerous agreements on economic, technical and cultural cooperation, Tunisia did not hesitate to support the sanctions imposed by the Security Council against Serbia and Montenegro.

Moreover, Tunisia is actively working within international and regional bodies to bring about a halt to the aggression against Bosnia and Herzegovina and to ensure respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of that country.
