**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
SAINT KITTS AND NEVIS AND THE REPUBLIC OF ICELAND**

Saint Kitts and Nevis and The Republic of Iceland,

With the purpose to promote mutual understanding and to strengthen the friendship and cooperation among their two Peoples,


On the basis of the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly on the respect for and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April, 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in duplicate, in English, both texts being equally authentic.
