Supplemental Information

1. The following report regarding a heavy exchange of fire in the Suez sector was received from the Chief of Staff of UNISEO at 1400 hours GMT on 4 September 1967:

"Heavy firing has been reported by UNMOS^{1/} at Port Tawfiq area. On 4 Sept at 0857Z ^{2/} firing was started by UAR and directed to Israeli motor boat sailing approx 3 km south Port Tawfiq in Suez Bay. The incident accelerated rapidly in an exchange of fire where tanks, artillery and mortars were used by both sides. The firing spread from Tawfiq area to some kilometres north of OP ^{3/} LIMA (MR 7662-8173). A ceasefire proposal for 1215Z was agreed to by both parties but was not effective at the time proposed. Firing became sporadic by approx 1300Z. Ismailia ^{4/} reports quiet at 1337Z."

2. A subsequent report was received from the Chief of Staff at 1515 hours GMT on the same day as follows:

"UNMOS at OP LIMA (MR 7662-8173) reported at 1324Z Israeli helicopter east of Canal drawing heavy UAR anti-aircraft fire. OP LIMA reports last firing at 1355Z."

3. As regards the Israel-Syria sector, reports from the Chief of Staff indicate that during the period from 28 August, the date of the last Supplemental Information (S/7930/Add.31), until 0800 hours GMT on 4 September, the situation remained generally quiet.
