Supplemental information

1. The following report is based on the information received from the Chief of Staff of UNTSO since the publication of the last supplemental information report, on 28 October 1967 (S/7930/Add.51).
2. Observation Post OP Mike (MR 7657-8037) reported that two Israel aircraft overflow the Suez Canal at 1118 hours GMT, 31 October, and were engaged by United Arab Republic anti-aircraft guns. Firing ceased at 1121 hours GMT.
3. OP Lima (MR 7762-8173) reported that two unidentified aircraft flying south-west to north-east over the Canal were engaged by UAR anti-aircraft artillery at 1123 hours GMT, 31 October. Firing ceased at 1125 hours GMT.
4. The Israel authorities complained that two UAR aircraft flew over the east bank of the Canal near Port Taufiq at 1120 hours GMT, 31 October. OP Mike confirmed that two UAR aircraft overflow the Canal in this area, at approximately 1113 hours GMT.
5. As regards the observation of the cease-fire in the Israel-Syria sector, reports from the Chief of Staff indicate that the situation remained generally quiet as of 0800 hours GMT, 1 November 1967.
