JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MAURITIUS <u>AND</u> THE REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA

The Government of the Republic of Mauritius and the Government of the Republic of The Gambia desirous of promoting relations of friendship and cooperation for mutual benefit between the two nations on the basis of equality, mutual respect of each other's sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity as well as noninterference in the internal affairs of each other,

Guided by the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as from the date of signature of this Communiqué.

These relations will be developed in conformity with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961.
