Order of discussion of agenda items (A/C.1/767 and Add.1) (continued)

- 1. The CHAIRMAN read out a letter dated 23 November 1955 addressed to him by the President of the General Assembly, in which it was stated that the representatives of Chile, Colombia, Cuba and Ecuador had submitted a proposal to the effect that the item entitled "The question of Algeria" should be deleted from the Assembly's agenda. The text of the letter was being circulated as an Assembly document, and a plenary meeting would take place on Friday, 25 November 1955, at 10.30 a.m. to consider the proposal.
- 2. Mr. TRUJILLO (Ecuador) said that the Committee should endeavour to assist in finding a solution of the problem in conformity with the principles of the United Nations. As one of the sponsors of the proposal and in accordance with rule 119 of the rules of procedure, his delegation moved the adjournment of the meeting to allow the members to continue the conversations and negotiations with regard to that question.

The motion was adopted by 46 votes to none, with 7 abstentions.

The meeting rose at 3.20 p.m.
