## **Approved resources for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018**

### **Note by the Secretary-General**

1. Pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution [49/233 A](#) of 23 December 1994, the present note reflects the approved resources for peacekeeping operations, the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi, Italy, the Regional Service Centre in Entebbe, Uganda, and the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018 (see annex).
2. In accordance with established practice, the present note has been prepared to reflect further financing actions taken by the General Assembly at the main part of its seventy-second session in respect of the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur (see resolution [72/259](#)) and the United Nations Mission for Justice Support in Haiti (see resolution [72/260](#)) (see annex).
