

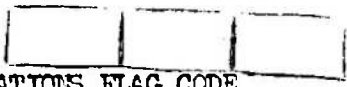

SECRETARY-GENERAL'S BULLETIN 2 NOV 1952

Subject: AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED NATIONS FLAG CODE
AND REGULATIONS

The Secretary-General, by virtue of the authority vested in him by Resolution 167 (II) of 20 October 1947 of the General Assembly, hereby further amends the Flag Code and Regulations adopted on 28 July 1950 and amended on 28 August 1950 by:

1. Substituting for the title of paragraph 4 of the Flag Code (ST/AFS/SGB/89) the title "Use of the Flag by the United Nations and Specialized Agencies of the United Nations".
2. Inserting in the Flag Code an additional sub-paragraph of paragraph 4 (ST/AFS/SGB/89) to be numbered paragraph 4 (3) reading "The flag may be flown from all buildings, offices and other property occupied by any Specialized Agency of the United Nations".
3. Substituting for paragraph V (b) of the Regulations (ST/AFS/SGB/89/Add.1) the following:

"V MOURNING (b) The Chiefs of the United Nations Missions, Directors of Information Centres and Heads of Specialized Agencies away from the Permanent Headquarters are authorized by the Secretary-General to lower the United Nations Flag to half-mast in cases where they wish to follow official mourning of the country in which such Mission, Information Centres and Specialized Agencies have their headquarters. The Chiefs of any Specialized Agency away from Permanent Headquarters may also lower the United Nations Flag to half-mast on any other occasion when the Specialized Agency concerned is in official mourning".
