Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the Secretary-General

1. By its resolution 71/323, the General Assembly decided to establish, at its seventy-second session, an ad hoc working group on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States.

2. In paragraph 5 of the same resolution, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit an update on the provisions of the Assembly resolutions on revitalization addressed to the Secretariat for implementation that had not been implemented, with an indication of the constraints and reasons behind any lack of implementation, for further consideration by the Ad Hoc Working Group at the seventy-second session.

3. The present report is being issued pursuant to that mandate (see annex).
