SECRETARY-GEEPRAL MAMES SPECIAL R PPRESETTATIVE FOR KECONSTRUCTIOAK<br>IN BOLIVIA, ECUADOR AND PERU FOLLOWLING VGTURAL DISASTERS


#### Abstract

The following statement was made today by the Spokesinan for the Secretary-General:


As is well known, an extensive area of South Anerica is being subjected to acute changes in ecological and weather patterns wnich are having a devastating effect on living conditions, tne economy and tne physical infrastructure of a large section of the resion. The tnree most affected countries are Bolivia, Ecuacior and Peru.

While the United Jations system has responded to this serious emergency by providing assistance with its own resources within the limits of its financial capacity, in order to serve as a catalyst for the mobilization of additional resources from the interational community, the Secretary-General Ceels that it is necessary to make a special effort to cater to the needs for rehavilitation and reconstruction in this area.

Accordingly, as a first step, and after consultations with the three Governinents concerned, the Secretary-General has decided co appoint Hugo Navajas-Mogro, Assistant Administrator and Regional Director of the United fations Developnent Programe for Latin America and tine Gdribbean, as his Personal Representative.

Mr. Navajas-Mogro will visit Bolivia, Ecuador and Peru in the forthconing days in order to evaluate, with high-level national authorities, tne extent or the danage to date and their plans for dealing with the energency, ane rehabilitation and the reconstruction which may have been established for the short- and medium-terin, as well as the subsequent steps that will nave to be taken with the support of the Secretary-General.
