GRO HAPLEN BRUITLAND APPOINTED CHAIRMAN OF SPECIAL COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL PERSPECTIVE

Secretary-General Javier Ferez de Cuellar today amounced the appointment of Pr. Gro Harlem Bruntland as Chairman of the Special Cormission on the Invironmental Perspective, in accordance with General Assembly resolution 38/161, adopted on Monday, 19 December.

Dr. Bruntland, who was Prime Minister of Morway From February to October 1981, is currently a member of the Norwegian Parliament, where she is Leader of the opposition Labour Party. She is also a member of the Independent Commission on Lisarmar ent and Security Issues, also known as the Islame Commission.

From 1974 to 1979, Dr. Eruntland was Forwegian Limister of the Environment.

Er. Pruntland, a medical doctor, is 44 years old and holds a Master's degree in public health.

Under the terms of resolution St/Iol, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General, in consultation with the Executive Director of the United bations Environment Programme (UPEr) and with Covernments, to name the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Commission and accordingly establish the Commission, which is to deal with the preparation of an environmental perspective to the year 2000 and beyond.
