**Joint Communiqué
on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations
between the
Republic of Maldives
and the
Republic of Cape Verde**

The Government of the Republic of Maldives and the Government of the Republic of Cape Verde, guided by the mutual willingness to develop fraternal ties of friendship and cooperation in political, economic, social, cultural, humanitarian and other fields, have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the two States as of the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué.

The two countries have agreed to establish diplomatic relations based on the principles and norms enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, International Law, and the principle of sovereign equality among states, mutual respect for territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States.

In witness whereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in the English language.


