Report of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) prepared in accordance with paragraph 6 of resolution 2375 (2017)

On 11 September 2017, the Security Council, by its resolution 2375 (2017), decided to apply the measures imposed under paragraph 6 of resolution 2371 (2017) on vessels transporting prohibited items from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and directed the Committee to designate these vessels and to regularly update this list when it is informed of additional violations.

In order to fulfil these tasks, the Committee considered a list of vessels for designation in accordance with paragraph 6 of resolution 2375 (2017).

On 28 December 2017, the Committee, acting in accordance with the Security Council's directive, approved the following list of vessels for designation:
