Elections, nominations, confirmations and appointments

Election of 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. Under the terms of its resolutions 1982/67 and 1985/71, the Economic and Social Council is to elect 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting, for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2019, to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2018 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Belarus, Benin, Brazil, Cameroon, Colombia, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Philippines, Uganda and Ukraine. In addition, the two seats from Asia-Pacific States and the one seat from Latin American and Caribbean States that remain vacant are to be filled.
- 2. The election will be held at the coordination and management meetings of the Council, to be held from 16 to 18 April 2018.
- 3. The members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
 - (a) Four members from African States;
- (b) Four members from Asia-Pacific States (includes two outstanding vacancies);
 - (c) Two members from Eastern European States;
- (d) Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States (includes one outstanding vacancy).
- 4. The membership of the Working Group in 2018 is listed in the annex to the present note.
