4. Elections, nominations, confirmations and appointments

The Council is to take action with regard to the following bodies:
Commission on Population and Development (E/2018/9)
Eight members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Two members from African States;
Two members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
Two members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
One member from Western European and other States.
In addition, there remain six outstanding vacancies on the Commission, as follows: two from Asia-Pacific States and one from Western European and other States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring at the close of the Commission's fifty-fourth session, in 2021; and two from African States and one from Asia-Pacific States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring at the close of the Commission's fifty-fifth session in 2022 (see Council decision 2018/201 B).

Commission for Social Development (E/2018/9)
Fourteen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Four members from African States;
Three members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;


Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Three members from Western European and other States.
In addition, there remain five outstanding vacancies on the Commission, as follows: two from Asia-Pacific States for a term expiring at the close of the Commission's fifty-ninth session, in 2021; and three from Western European and other States; two for a term expiring at the close of the Commission's fifty-ninth session, in 2021, and one for a term expiring at the close of the Commission's fifty-eighth session in 2020, all for terms beginning on the date of election (see Council decision 2017/201 B).

## Commission on the Status of Women (E/2018/9)

Eleven members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Three members from African States;
Two members from Asia-Pacific States;
Two members from Eastern European States;
One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Three members from Western European and other States.

## Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (E/2018/9)

Twenty members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Four members from African States;
Five members from Asia-Pacific States;
Two members from Eastern European States;
Five members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Four members from Western European and other States.
In addition, there remain two outstanding vacancies on the Commission for members from African States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2020 (see Council decision 2018/201 B).

## Commission on Science and Technology for Development (E/2018/9)

Twenty-three members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Six members from African States;
Five members from Asia-Pacific States;
Three members from Eastern European States;
Four members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Five members from Western European and other States.
In addition, there remains one outstanding vacancy on the Commission for a member from Western European and other States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2020 (see Council decision 2017/201 B).

Committee for Programme and Coordination (E/2018/9/Add.3)
Seven members are to be nominated for election by the General Assembly according to the following pattern:

Two members from African States;
One member from Eastern European States;
Two members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Two members from Western European and other States (includes one outstanding vacancy).
In addition, there remain four outstanding vacancies on the Committee as follows: One from African States, one from Latin American and Caribbean States, and one from Western European and other States for election by the General Assembly for a term beginning on the date of election by the General Assembly and expiring on 31 December 2020; and one from Western European and other States, for a term beginning on the date of election by the General Assembly and expiring on 31 December 2018; (see Council decision 2018/201 B).

Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations (E/2018/9/Add.4)
Nineteen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Five members from African States;
Four members from Asia-Pacific States;
Two members from Eastern European States;
Four members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Four members from Western European and other States.
Committee for Development Policy (E/2018/9/Add.15) ${ }^{1}$
Under the terms of resolutions 1998/46 and 1998/47, the Council is to consider the nomination by the Secretary-General of 24 experts who will serve on the Committee in their personal capacity for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2019.

Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (E/2018/9/Add. 5 and E/2018/9/Add.6)

Nine members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Two members from African States;
Two members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
One member from Western European and other States.

## Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting (E/2018/9/Add.7)

Thirteen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Four members from African States;
Four members from Asia-Pacific States (includes two outstanding vacancies);
Two members from Eastern European States;
Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States (includes one outstanding vacancies).

In addition, there remain 21 outstanding vacancies on the Working Group, as follows: two from Asia-Pacific States and one from Latin American and Caribbean States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2018; and four from African States, three from Asia-Pacific States, three from Latin American and Caribbean States and eight from Western European and other States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2020 (see Council decision 2018/201 B).

## Executive Board of the United Nations Children's Fund (E/2018/9/Add.8)

Fourteen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Five members from African States;
Three members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Four members from Western European and other States.

## Executive Committee of the Programme of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 72/151, the Council is to elect an additional member to the Executive Committee, thereby increasing the membership of the Committee from 101 to 102 .

## Executive Board of the United Nations Development Programme/United Nations Population Fund/United Nations Office for Project Services (E/2018/9/Add.9)

Fourteen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Five members from African States;
Three members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Four members from Western European and other States.

## Executive Board of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (E/2018/9/Add.10)

Seventeen members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Five members from African States;
Five members from Asia-Pacific States;
Two members from Eastern European States;
Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Two members from Western European and other States.
Executive Board of the World Food Programme (E/2018/9/Add.11)
Six members are to be elected from the States included in the lists contained in annex III to document E/2018/9/Add. 11 according to the following pattern:

One member from the States included in List A;
Two members from the States included in List B;
Two members from the States included in List D;
One member from the States included in List E.
Committee for the United Nations Population Award (E/2018/9/12)
Ten members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Three members from African States;
Three members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
Two members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
One member from Western European and other States.

## Programme Coordinating Board of the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (E/2018/9/Add.13)

Nine members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Two members from African States;
Two members from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Three members from Western European and other States.

## Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

 (UN-Habitat) (E/2018/9/Add.14)Twenty members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
Six members from African States;
Four members from Asia-Pacific States;
Two members from Eastern European States;

Four members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
Four members from Western European and other States.
There remain five outstanding vacancies on the Governing Council, as follows: one member from Latin American and Caribbean States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2020; and four members from Western European and other States, all for terms beginning on the date of election and expiring as follows: two for a term expiring on 31 December 2018; one for a term expiring on 31 December 2019 and one for a term expiring on 31 December 2020 (see decision 2018/201 B).

## Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission ${ }^{2}$

The Council is to elect seven members to the Organizational Committee from among members of the Council for a two-year term beginning on 1 January 2019 and expiring on 31 December 2020. In accordance with Council resolution 2015/1, the distribution of seats is as follows:

One member from African States;
One member from Asia-Pacific States;
One member from Eastern European States;
One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;
One member from Western European and other States;
Two additional States members of the Council.
The attention of the Council is also drawn to the subsidiary body set out below, which has an outstanding vacancy from a previous session.

## Statistical Commission

There remains one outstanding vacancy on the Commission from African States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2021.
