APPOIN'IMENT OF TEMPORARY LONDON OFFICE PERSONNEL TO NEW YORK STAFF

- 1. Reference is made to the Secretary-General's Bulletin No. 1 dated 4 March 1946, which is now modified with respect to Temporary London Office personnel appointed to New York staff.
- 2. Appointment of persons employed in the Temporary London Office to positions in the headquarters office in New York will require:
 - (a) Approval by the Assistant Secretary-General for Administrative and Financial Services (or, pending his appointment, by the Special Assistant to the Secretary-General for Administration and Finance). This action will be based on:
 - (i) A request by the appropriate official in New York; and
 - (ii) Approval by the Bureau of Personnel in New York.
 - (b) Approval by the Executive Director of the Temporary London Office on receipt of an advice from the Assistant Secretary-General for Administrative and Financial Services.
- 3. Prior authorization for travel of approved appointees will be obtained in accordance with the provisions of Secretary-General's Bulletin No. 7 (Addendum 1), dated 14 March 1946.
- 4. Classification and salary determinations for posts in New York filled by members of the staff of the Temporary London Office will be made in accordance with the provisions outlined in Secretary-General's Bulletin No. 1 (Addendum 1) dated 11 March 1946.
