Subject: OFFICIAL HOLIDAYS FOR THE UNITED NATIONS

- Effective at once, official holidays of the United Nations will generally coincide with those customerily observed in the countries in which its offices are located.
- The headquarters staff in the New York area will observe the following holiday ...

New Year's Day Washington's Birthday Memorial Day Independence Day Labor Day Armistice Day Thanksgiving Day Christmas Day

- When one of these holidays falls on Saturday or Sunday, the Secretary-General ordinarily will declare the following Monday a holiday.
- Staff members who are nationals of any country having a "national day other than 4 July may observe that "national day" also as a holiday.
- Staff members desiring to observe religious or other additional dayof particular importance to them should arrange with their supervisors to take annual leave on these days. It shall be the policy of the organizati to grant requests for such leave whenever feasible.
