Excellency,



**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
AND
GRENADA**

The Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam and the Government of Grenada,

Desirous of strengthening the friendly relations and cooperation between the two states on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, the peaceful settlement of disputes, and in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, and respect for international law,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the Provisions of the 1961 Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations at Ambassadorial level as from the dates of the signing of the Joint Communiqué.

Done in New York, on 29 January 2010, in two copies, both texts being equally authentic.
