Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 24th meeting, on 9 November 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/27) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/42/L.16. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/42/SR.24).

DECISIONS OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/42/L.16, it is estimated that an additional appropriation of \$104,000 would be required under section 1 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989.
