Under the arrangements made by the Fifth Committee at the eighth session of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General on 21 May 1962
 addressed the annexed communication to Member States informing them of the opening date of the next session of the Committee on Contributions.
 A summary of the information and data submitted by Member States in reply to the Secretary-General's communication is given in the following:

## ANNEX

The Secretary-General of the United Nations presents his compliments to the Permanent Representative of ..... and, in compliance with the arrangements made by the Fifth Committee at the eighth session of the General Assembly, has the honour to announce that the next session of the Committee on Contributions is scheduled to open in Geneva on 18 July next. The session is expected to last about one to two weeks.

The Committee is convened under rule 161 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, which requires the Committee to "advise the General Assembly on the assessments to be fixed for new Members," and under resolution 1691 (XVI), which in paragraph 5 provides that "the Committee on Contributions shall at its meeting in 1962 examine the scale of assessments for the years 1962, 1963 and 1964, in the light of the discussion in the Fifth Committee at the sixteenth session and in the light of such further information as might be made available to it, and shall report thereon to the General Assembly at its seventeenth session...".

At its session in 1961, the Committee on Contributions used as a basis for drawing up the scale of assessments for 1962-1964, national income estimates for the three-year period 1957-1959, and for its review of the scale will use national income estimates for the same base period. If Member States should wish to submit supplementary data relevant to the work of the Committee on Contributions, it would be helpful if such data or information could be received as soon as possible and, at the latest, by 15 June 1962.
