STATISTICS OF THE CENTRALLY PLANNED ECONOMIES

Yugoslavia

The following communication has been addressed to the Chairman of the Committee on Contributions by the Permanent Representative of Yugoslavia to the United Nations:

26 May 1961

"With reference to your letter No. FI 313(1)IPP, of 19 May 1961, I have the honour to inform that the methods used by my country for the computation of national income are based on material production.

"Personal services, free professions, administrative services and housing are compensated from the national income as computed on the basis of material production. Consequently, their inclusion in the national income estimates would mean a duplication.

"I further have the honour to confirm that, in 1953, the share of the economically active population engaged in agriculture was approximately 68 per cent."
